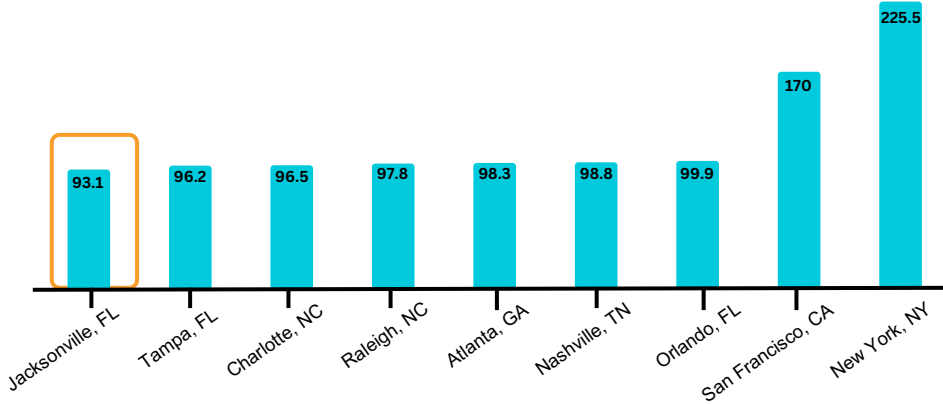

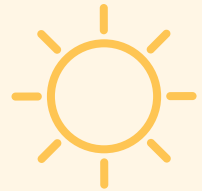
HEALTH & WELLNESS
