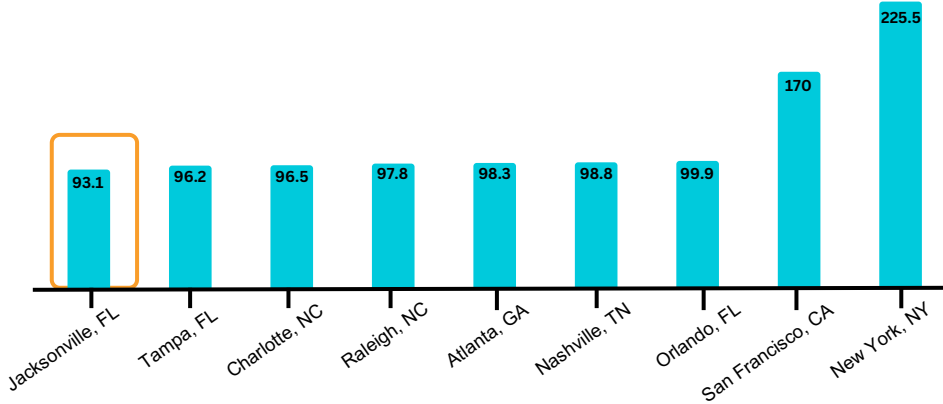

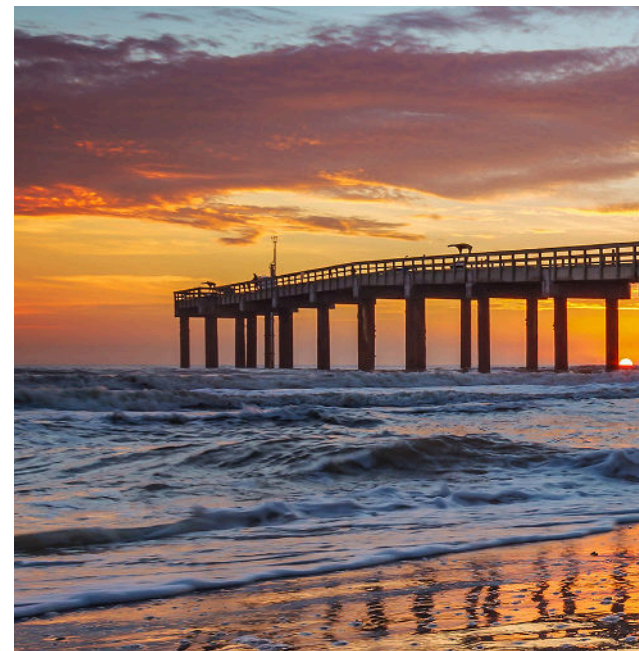
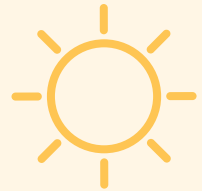
HEALTH & WELLNESS
